List of Competition Rules and teams Procedures for the NAIGC Virtual Championships

1. **Equipment:** When submitting any video to Virtual Stars you are agreeing to these terms and equipment standards and ensuring these equipment specifications:
 - a. Ensure that all equipment specifications are correct and up to USAG/NAIGC Gymnastics standards, and ensure that all equipment is installed properly. (Pit landings must be converted to hard landings with the same measurements as any competitive USAG competition standard).
 - b. There cannot be any obstructions on the floor exercise area, if so these videos will be deleted.
 - c. Gymnasts must be in their usual competitive NAIGC attire/ Their uniform must be USAG/NAIGC appropriate and fall under USAG/NAIGC standards.
2. **Timing:** Any videos submitted to a Virtual Stars competition must be recorded during standard competition times. Athletes should not be kept in the gym over 5 hours and no routines can be recorded prior to 8:00am or after 10:00pm. Videos may not be dated from a previous season or competition. **A single date, weekend, or week** must be provided below that all videos were recorded for the Virtual Stars competition, and they cannot be from any other competition; the videos must be videoed with the sole purpose of using them for Virtual Stars, 2018. It is acceptable to use the athlete's best video.
3. **Gymnastics Body:** Any routine submitted that does not show a full gymnastics body from mount to dismount is subject to score a 0.0 from an online judge based on whether the judge feels that the video compromised the judge's professional assessment.
4. **Cheating:** A judge can give a 0.0 to any routine that looks like it was video manipulated or "cut and pasted". This is cheating and a team may be subject to disqualification.
5. **Judge Inquiry:** There will be no inquiring about start values or deductions from judges or disputing a score of 0.0.
6. **Injury:** Virtual Stars Team Championships is not responsible for any injury during performance. The club in which the gymnast trains will be responsible for any injuries.
